INFORMATION LETTER

In order to carry out research activities in higher educational institutions, further expand the scope of scientific, methodological and research activities in the social and humanitarian sphere, familiarize with new views, ideas and theories put forward in scientific articles and theses, the Department of Ethics and Aesthetics of NUUZ in collaboration with SCU named after M. Auezov plans to hold an international conference on April 24, 2024 on the topic “Modern trends and current issues in the social sciences and humanities” and the publication of an electronic scientific collection of conference materials. The scientific collection will be indexed in the scientific search engine GoogleScholar (Google Scholar) according to modern standards for publishing articles, and the collection will be assigned a DOI number.

The scientific collection of the conference may contain articles on current issues in the social sciences and humanities, on a specific topic and scientific problem in this area. The materials will be compiled in the form of an electronic scientific collection in April 2024. Articles will be accepted in Uzbek, Russian and English languages until April 15, 2024. All materials will be indexed in scientific databases such as Google Scholar, Cyberleninka and will be assigned a DOI number.

Costs associated with the formation of a scientific collection, editing and indexing in the scientific search engine GoogleScholar (Google Scholar) will be covered by the organizational fee of the authors of the article (Organization fee is 150,000 soums for each article).

Requirements for the content and format of articles:

1. The minimum volume of materials for the collection is 5 pages;

2. Font Times New Roman, spacing 1.5, point size 14, margins: 2 cm top and bottom, 1.5 cm right, 3 cm left.

3. The title of the article is written in capital letters and in bold type; the next line indicates the author's first and last name, place of work, academic degree and title, position, name of educational institution, telephone number, e-mail.

4. Abstract of the article: 150-300 words (usually 5-8 sentences). Must be in 3 languages (Uzbek, Russian, English). The abstract should not be italicized, underlined, etc. The text should not be divided into paragraphs. Quotations and references to other works are not allowed in the abstract. Abbreviations must be deciphered. The abstract must contain:

- Description of the main purpose of the study;
- Brief description of the methodology;
- Summarize the most important findings of the study and their implications.

5. The article must contain keywords (at least 7) in 3 languages (Uzbek, Russian, English).

6. The literature used must consist of at least 3-4 sources (literature titles).

7. Links to the article (footnotes) are in the form [1,2, ...] at the end of the article. **In the "Bibliography" section**, the reference number is indicated in sequence.

8. The author is responsible for the accuracy, correctness and absence of copying of information and evidence in the article.

9. Articles that are not related to the topic, have not been edited and are presented with spelling errors will not be included in the scientific collection.

Memo: The registration fee is **150,000 thousand soums** for each article. Scientific articles will be accepted until **April 15, 2024**.
