You should say:

You should say:

- where it occurred
- what harm it caused

1. What kind of lifestyle do you think is healthiest for people?
2. How do you balance your personal life with other responsibilities, such as work or school?
3. What is a hobby you think everyone should try? Why?

You should say:

- what it was
- when it was
- where you have worked and explain why you have worked there.

24. Describe a foreign culture that you like.

- You should say:
- what culture it is
- how you know about it
- what differences there are between that culture and your own and explain why you like that foreign culture.

25. Academic question: A speech that somebody gave and you liked.

You should say:

- when it was
- who gave the speech and what it was about
- who were present there and explain why it was the best gift/ present you have ever received.

26. Describe a time that you can remember when you were very afraid.

You should say:

- what happened
- where you were then
- who was with you and explain why you were so afraid.

27. Describe a foreign country you want to visit but haven't been to.

You should say:

- where this place is
- what it is like
- what you can do in this country and explain why you want to visit the country.

You should say:

- who is he/she
